Teaching is expected at the bachelor and master program, for the latter with a focus on the Middle East. The teaching load will be 6.5 hours/week during the lecture period.

Our requirements are an outstanding graduation in Economics (or comparable) with a degree qualifying for a PhD program (like Master, Magister, Diplom, first State Examination for Teachers) with a sound knowledge of economic and statistical methods, a sound knowledge of economic related topics (such as Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Development Economics, Environmental Economics) and an excellent level of written and spoken German and English.
